Dress Code

Uniforms are to be worn by all students from Kindergarten through Grade 8. Specific uniform regulations are as follows:

Boy's Uniforms:

- Dark navy blue pants (No jeans, baggy pants or cargo pants). If the waistband is not elasticized, then a belt must be worn. Belt must be plain black, brown or navy. (No designer belt buckles)
- White knit polo shirt with collar (plain or with SCS/Blue Ribbon logo).
- White knit turtleneck during winter months.
- All shirts must be tucked in.
- Navy blue or red cardigan sweater. (No hooded sweaters).
- Gray fleece pullover with our St. Casimir logo can be worn and is available at Dennis Uniform.
- Navy blue, black or white dress socks (Socks must cover the ankles).
- Navy blue uniform walking shorts may be worn from May 1 to Nov. 1.
- NEW St. Casimir School gym uniform. This is available at Dennis Uniform.
- Navy, black or brown dress school shoes or solid black or white tennis shoes (No high tops. No bright colored logos, stripes, designs, etc.) Shoe laces must be black or white.
- Athletic shoes are to be worn with gym uniform.
- Winter boots may be worn to and from school, but not during the school day.
- Shirts must be tucked in.
- No undergarments may be exposed (plain white under shirts only).

Girl's Uniforms:

- Plaid jumper for grades K-4 (purchase at Dennis Uniform).
- Solid navy blue slacks (No jeans, baggy pants, tight fitting pants, no boot cut pants, skinny, stretch or cargo pants) for K-8. If the waistband is not elasticized then a belt must be worn. Belt must be plain black, brown or navy. (No designer belt buckles)
- White plain uniform blouses (to be worn with jumpers only, not with school pants).
- White knit polo shirt with button collar for K-8 (plain or with SCS/Blue Ribbon logo).
- White knit turtleneck during winter months.
- All shirts/blouses must be tucked in.
- Navy blue or red cardigan sweater. (No hooded sweaters)
- Gray fleece pullover with our St. Casimir logo can be worn and is available at Dennis Uniform.
- Navy blue or white or red dress socks. (Socks must cover the ankles)
- Uniform walking shorts may be worn from May 1 to Nov. 1 (No capris).
- NEW St. Casimir School gym uniform. This is available at Dennis Uniform.
- Navy, black or brown dress school shoes or solid black or white tennis shoes (No high tops. No bright colored logos, stripes, designs, etc.). Shoe laces must be black or white.
- No clogs, sandals, shoes with skates or high heels will be allowed.
- Athletic shoes are to be worn with gym uniform
- All jumpers must hit the knees.
- White undergarments only.
- No skirts are permitted school wide.

Hairstyles

St. Casimir students are to keep their hair clean and appropriately styled. Conservative hairstyles are the only hairstyles permitted. Head shaving, whether on the sides or the entire head is not allowed. (Mohawks/spiked hairstyles are not allowed). Students must have their natural normal hair color (No streaking or highlights). Hair accessories (i.e. head bands, barrettes, and bows) must be conservative and in compliance with the school uniform. Hair accessories including feathers, flowers, oversized bows, or fake colored false hair pieces are not permitted. Bangs for both boys and girls cannot obstruct the students' vision. Boys' hair length should not exceed in length beyond the base of the head (in direct proportion with the tip of the ear lobes). No facial hair is permitted. Must be clean-shaven. Questionable or inappropriate styles or colors will be reviewed on an individual basis.

This policy is in effect the first day of school. Please check your child's hair style and color before bringing him/her to school

Additional Dress Code Information

- Watches are permitted
- Girls are allowed to wear one earring in each ear. (Studs only No hoops or dangling earrings)
- Boys are not permitted to wear earrings
- One religious necklace is allowed (simple cross or religious medal, 15 or 18 inch chain). School is not responsible for lost or broken jewelry.
- No bracelets.
- No other jewelry, including rings.
- No fingernail polish, fake nails, nail tips, etc.
- No face or eye makeup
- Eyebrow shaving is NOT allowed.
- No facial or body piercing.
- No permanent or temporary tattoos.

On occasion, students may have a dress up or a dress down day in which they will be out of uniform. A respectful and neat appearance should be maintained on these days. Tight fitting tops, tank tops, bare midriffs, spandex slacks, leggings or tight pants are NOT allowed. Skirts should not be worn high above the knee or with high slits on the sides. Sandals, flip flops and boots are not permitted. (All other dress code policies apply i.e. earrings, nail polish, make up, ect...)

On uniform days, students must always leave the school in their school uniform.

Physical Education Dress Code

All students must wear gym shoes. <u>NEW</u> St. Casimir gym uniforms (including mandatory t-shirt and sweatpants and optional shorts and sweatshirt) are required of students in grades K-8. All gym uniforms must be purchased at Dennis Uniform Company in Highland. Students out of uniform will not participate in gym class. **No jewelry of any kind is to be worn on gym day**.
